

## Online Virtual Classroom - Commencing Saturday 5th September at 10:00AM




## **Zoom Virtual Classroom**

As advised, we will be using the e-learning platform called Zoom which is being used by many madrasas and maktabs around the world. It can be used on any device; PC, Mac, IOS or Android, but it would be best if you do not use a mobile phone. You are requested to ensure headsets are used to maintain good sound quality. To ensure best quality please sit your child near your router if using WiFi and away from other family members and back ground noise where possible. We look to you to ensure your child is focused on the learning and behaving well as it is impossible to do this remotely.

You will be provided with a link via Whatsapp for your child's class similar to: <a href="https://zoom.us/j/038625877">https://zoom.us/j/038625877</a>. Once selected you will be presented with the following screen asking you to download an add-on to run the meeting. Select Run.



You will then be asked for your name. Please enter your child's full name and their class number e.g. Ayesha Hussain Class 4 (where known). After which you will enter in to the classroom as per below diagram. If you have previously used Zoom or were not asked for your name, please update it via Participants and More on the Left-hand screen. Please ensure you connect before 10AM. We will have the classroom open from 9:30AM.



## **Classroom Etiquettes**

All participants must be on mute and a reminder a **headset\headphones must be used**. Students will be unable to interact with their peers and the teacher without one. The teacher will unmute children as and when required. If a child has a question, they can select the Raise Hand option (as per above diagram). Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for a learning environment. This will help facilitate the learning.
